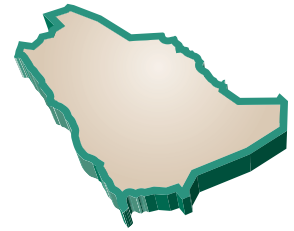




# SAUDI ARABIA

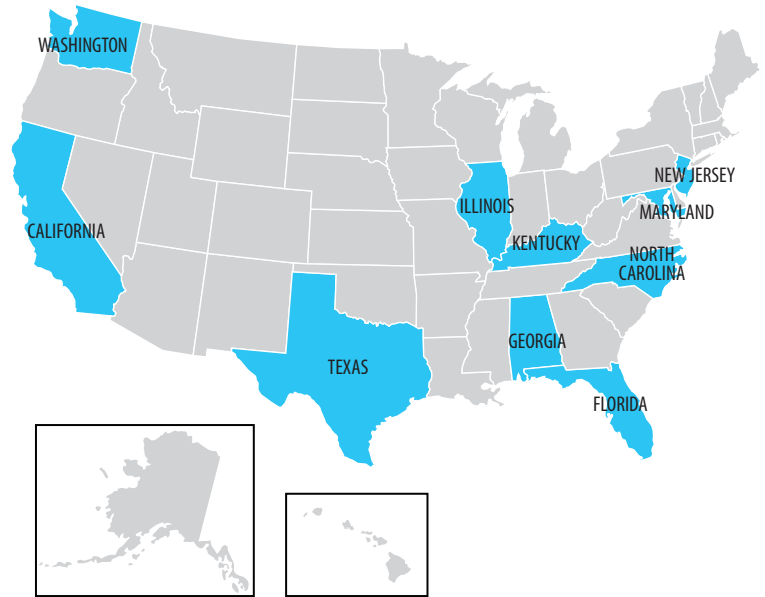


## 2014 Ranking: 20th Largest Export Market for U.S. Goods (2013: 19th)

In 2004 the Trade and Investment Framework Agreement (TIFA) was signed by the U.S. and Saudi Arabia. With a steady growth in the exports between the two countries since 2009, today Saudi Arabia is the second largest export destination for the United States. There was a slight decrease of 1.35 percent in 2014 in the total exports to Saudi Arabia of \$18.7 billion, and a decrease of 9.2 percent in products imported from Saudi Arabia. Among the top imported sectors from the U.S. are Transportation Equipment; Machinery (except Electrical); and Chemicals.

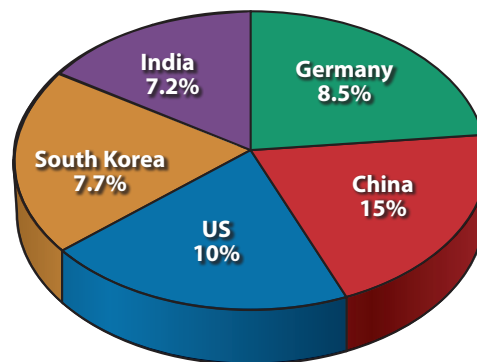
