



**Dr. Eiman Al Mutairi, PH.D.**

**Head of Tayseer**

Dr. Eiman Al-Mutairi has a unique and extensive background in the field of science and healthcare, leadership and management. She was awarded the Bachelor's of Science degree in Chemistry from King Faisal University in Dammam. She earned a Ph.D. while on scholarship from Bristol University (UK) in Bio-Organic Chemistry.

Dr. Al-Mutairi was then awarded a Fulbright Scholarship to undertake post-doctorate work in Molecular Biology and Genetics from Harvard University. A year later she was awarded the King Faisal Foundation Scholarship to continue her genetics research at Harvard. A third scholarship was then awarded by Harvard for advanced molecular biology and genetics research. While undertaking this research Dr. Al-Mutairi taught genetics at the Harvard Science Center.

She completed her research in the United States in Chicago, where she worked for PerkinElmer Life Sciences for three years. Dr. Al-Mutairi then returned to Saudi Arabia where she held several leadership positions in the healthcare organization of Saudi Aramco, culminating as the Director of the Support Services of the Saudi Aramco Medical Services Organization.

After leading and completing the integration project of the joint-venture between Saudi Aramco Healthcare Services and Johns Hopkins University Medical Services, she founded a highly regarded consultancy. In this capacity Dr. Al-Mutairi has worked with governmental and private sector agencies on projects ranging from the establishment of new operating models and enhancing the care delivery systems of the disability centers, to developing succession planning programs and performing clinical audits.

In 2017 Dr. Al-Mutairi was appointed advisor for the Minister of Commerce and Investment to head the transformation office in the Saudi Arabian General Investment Authority. (SAGIA). Currently, Dr. Al-Mutairi is advisor to His Excellency the Minister of Commerce and Investment as well as the General Administrator of the Reform Committee and Department "Tayseer." She also coordinates the partnership agreement between the Ministry of Commerce and Investment and the World Bank.
