- September 2009 November 2011: Chairman of the General Organization for Physical Planning (GOPP), Ministry of Housing, Utilities and Urban Development. Major projects included Egypt's National Urban Plan till 2052, Greater Cairo Region Urban Strategic Plan till 2050, Alexandria Urban Development Plan till 2032, Strategic Plans for the North Coast, Sinai Peninsula, North West Suez Gulf area, and Upper Egypt.
