



His Excellency Omar Behi

Tunisian Minister of Commerce

His Excellency Omar Behi holds a PhD from the University of Montpellier. He has a diploma of advanced studies in soil sciences from the Institut National Agronomique Paris-Grignon and a degree in plant production from the National Agricultural Institute of Tunisia (INAT).

Minister Behi has held the positions of treasurer and vice-president in charge of animal production at INAT and, following the revolution of 2011, at the Tunisian Union of Agriculture and Fisheries.

As a farmer in the crops field and in animal production, Behi conducted research and academic studies in his specialization.

On August 27, 2016, Behi became Secretary of State for Agricultural Production under the leadership of Youssef Chahed, Head of Government of Tunisia. On September 12, 2017, Behi was appointed Minister of Commerce.
