

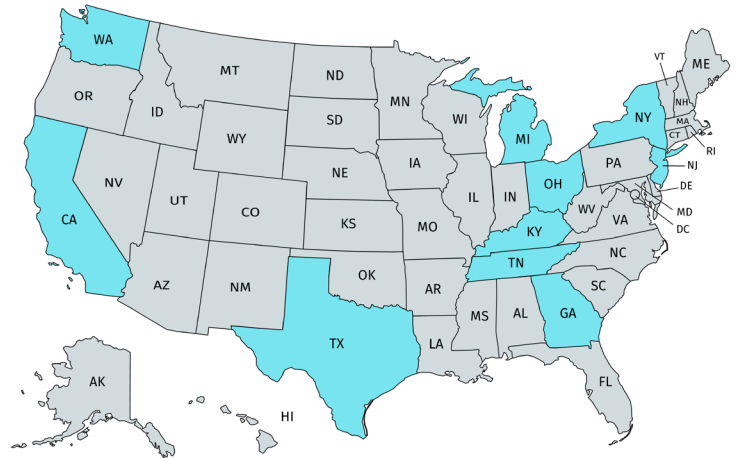


2019 Ranking: 7th Largest Export Market for U.S. Goods in the Arab World

Following a surge of 22% in 2018, U.S. goods exports in 2019 decreased 19.78%. Oman's goods exported to the United States decreased by 9.07% during the same period. Oman's top imported sectors were Transportation Equipment, Used or Second-Hand Merchandise, Machinery (except Electrical), Chemicals and Computer & Electronic Products.

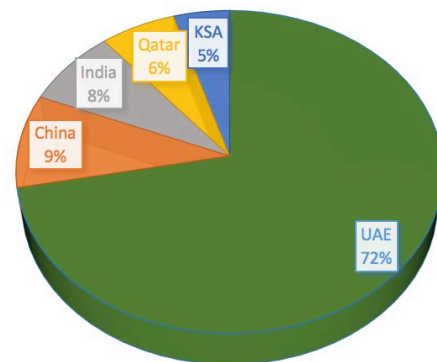
