#### **DIRECTIONS**

Please enter through the entrance labelled United States Diplomacy Center just south of the intersection of Virginia Avenue and 21st Street NW. The best way to approach the building is from the north, as 21st Street is a one-way southbound only street.

#### **PARKING**

Please note that parking is **very limited** around the State Department, thus we recommend travelling via taxi or metro. There are several paid parking lots in the area – at Columbia Plaza on 23rd Street and around the George Washington University.

#### **METRO/PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION**

The closest metro station is Foggy Bottom/GWU, which is located at 23rd and I Streets NW on the Blue and Orange Lines.

#### **IMPORTANT SECURITY INFORMATION**

This event will be held at the George C. Marshall Center in the U.S. Department of State's main building. When you enter the center, you will be required to go through a security checkpoint. You will need to present a **government-issued photo ID** and enter through a metal detector to gain access to the building.
