






2022 Ranking: 8th Largest Export Market in MENA for U.S. Goods

The Oman – U.S. Free Trade Agreement (FTA) came into force on January 1, 2009. Designed to promote trade between these two long-time partners, the FTA provides preferential treatment, creating a comparative export advantage for Omani firms over other companies around the globe. In part because of this FTA, U.S. goods exports to Oman grew to nearly \$1.5 billion in 2022, representing an increase of 6 percent from 2021.
