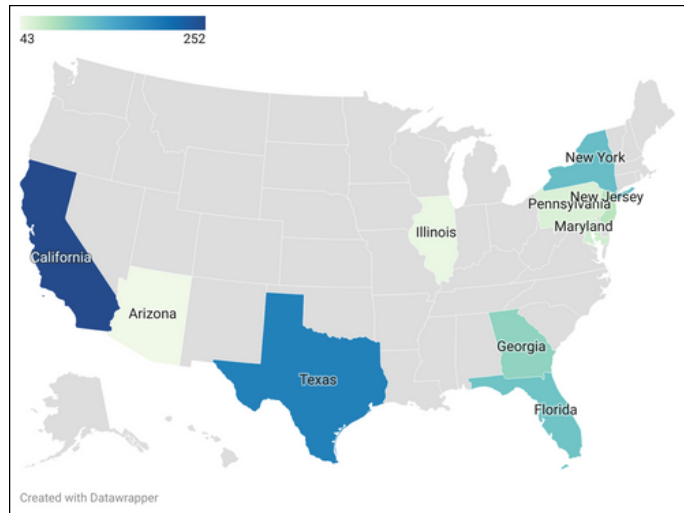

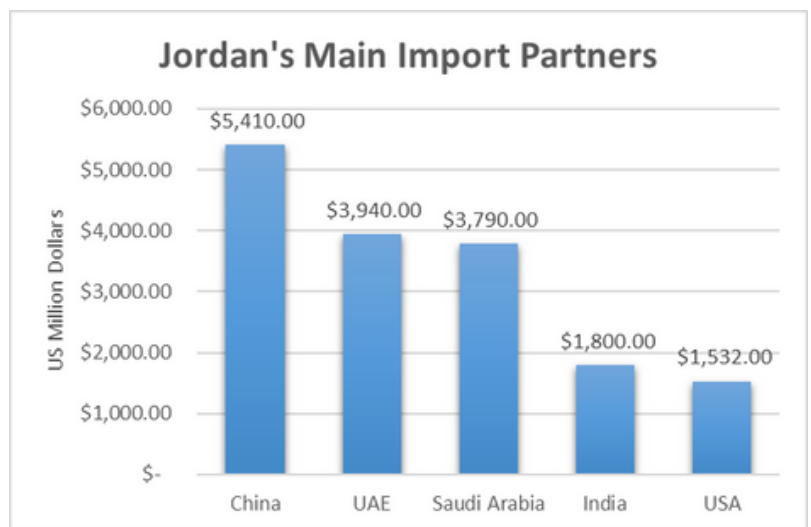
2023 Ranking: 10th Largest Export Market in MENA for U.S. Goods

Jordan was the first Arab country to sign a Free Trade Agreement with the United States. It entered into force in 2001, and by 2010, nearly all tariffs had been rescinded. In 2023, there was a 0.50% decrease in goods exports from the United States to the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan. Jordan's top imported sectors were Transportation Equipment, Used or Second-Hand Merchandise, Processed Foods, Agricultural Products, and Oil & Gas.
