In his capacity as Associate Director at the National U.S.–Arab Chamber of Commerce (NUSACC), Almudhaf facilitates engagement with stakeholders across the United States and the MENA region.

As NUSACC's lead researcher, Almudhaf delivers tailored research for U.S. and Arab governments and companies, including small and medium-sized enterprises and new-to-market exporters and importers. His contributions have been instrumental in fortifying commercial ties between the U.S. and the Arab world, helping NUSACC earn the 2024 E Star Award – conferred by the President of the United States – the highest honor that a U.S. entity may receive for supporting America's exports. (NUSACC is the only Chamber of its kind to receive this award since it was created six decades ago.)

Almudhaf earned his undergraduate degree from The Elliott School of International Affairs at The George Washington University, specializing in Conflict Resolution with a minor in International Business.

For five decades, the National U.S. - Arab Chamber of Commerce (NUSACC) has served as America's top commercial gateway to the Middle East and North Africa (MENA). Widely regarded as the voice of American business in the Arab world, the Chamber serves over 50,000 members and stakeholders in the USA and across the MENA region. NUSACC is the only chamber of its kind to be awarded the E Star Award for Export Excellence by the President of the United States, and NUSACC is the only business entity in the USA that is officially recognized by the League of Arab States and the Union of Arab Chambers.
