PDI, for example, matches select Arab graduates of U.S. universities with premier American companies. In his capacity as Associate Director, he works to develop strategic relationships for NUSACC with prospective partners in the public and private sectors.

Raised in the State of Kuwait, Mr. Almudhaf received his undergraduate degree from The Elliott School of International Affairs at The George Washington University, with a concentration in Conflict Resolution and a minor in Business Administration. In 2018, he was a legal intern at Lewis Baach Kaufman Middlemiss PLLC, where he was tasked with researching substantive support for legal arguments.
