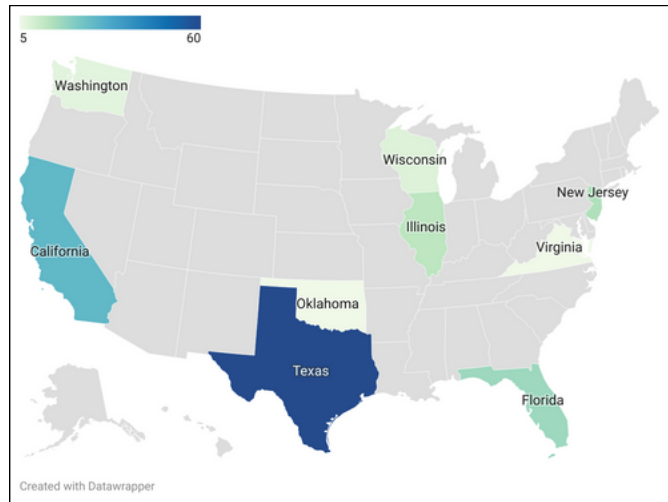


Djibouti

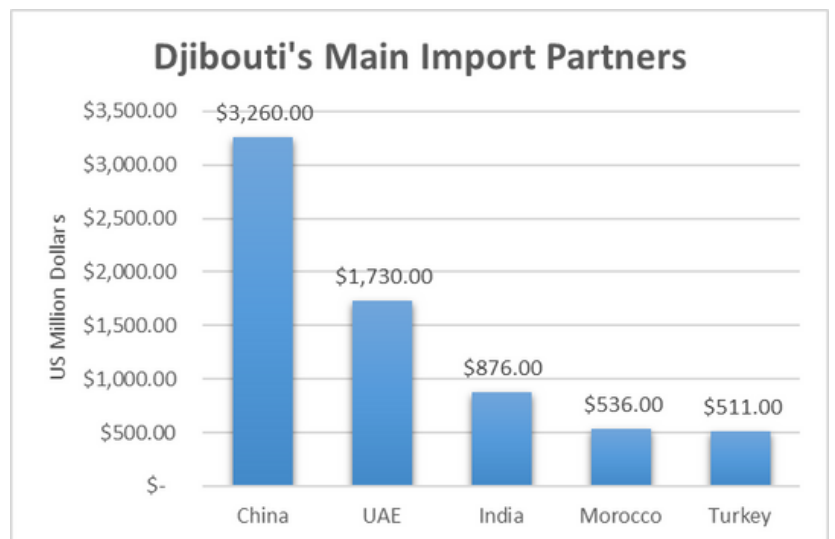
2023 Ranking: 15th Largest Export Market in MENA for U.S. Goods

Djibouti is eligible for U.S. trade benefits under the African Growth and Opportunities Act of 2000, which extends preferential access for imports from beneficiary Sub-Saharan African countries until June 2025. In 2023, there was a 6.21% increase in goods exports from the United States to Djibouti. Djibouti's top imported sectors were Agricultural Products, Computer & Electronic Products, Machinery (Except Electrical), Processed Foods, and Transportation Equipment.
