



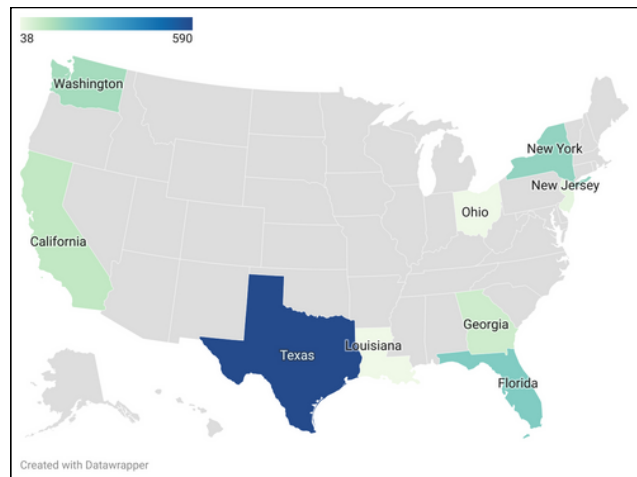

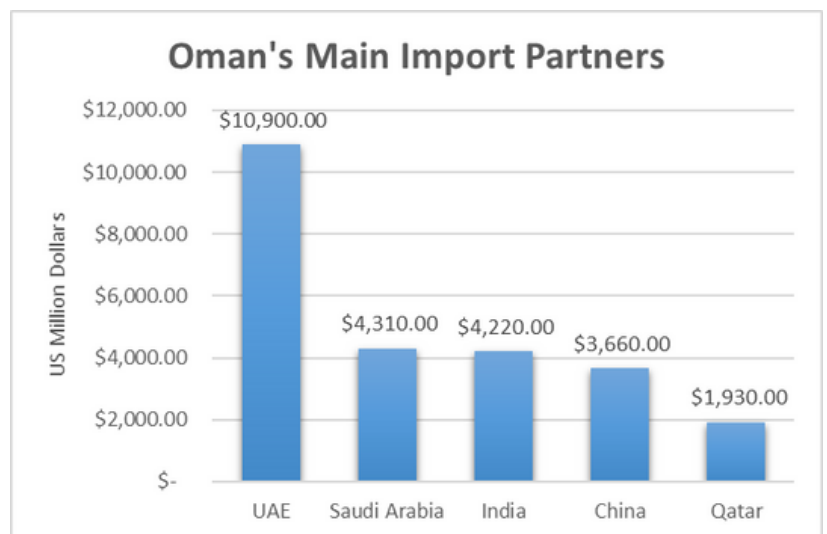
2023 Ranking: 8th Largest Export Market in MENA for U.S. Goods

The Oman – U.S. Free Trade Agreement (FTA) came into force on January 1, 2009. Designed to promote trade between these two long-time partners, the FTA provides preferential treatment, creating a comparative export advantage for Omani firms over other companies around the globe. In 2023, there was a 25.22% increase in goods exports from the United States to the Sultanate of Oman. Oman's top imported sectors were Used or Second-Hand Merchandise, Transportation Equipment, Chemicals, Machinery, Except Electrical, and Primary Metal Manufactures.
